In spite of the exceptional transitional circumstances our host country is going through we continued to do our work and to serve: we organized the 13th session of the Mediterranean Oil and Gas Conference in 2014, which was attended by more than 300 participants from Libya and abroad as well as other three international conferences. IEF has also held 42 training workshops with over 250 trainees; seven of these workshops were held abroad. Last and not least I am pleased to announce shortly the opening of our international branches in Istanbul and Vienna with the aim to increase our international presence and benefit from knowledge available abroad.

Provision of technical, administrative and logistical support for IEF-members, who are operating or intend to start operations in Libya.

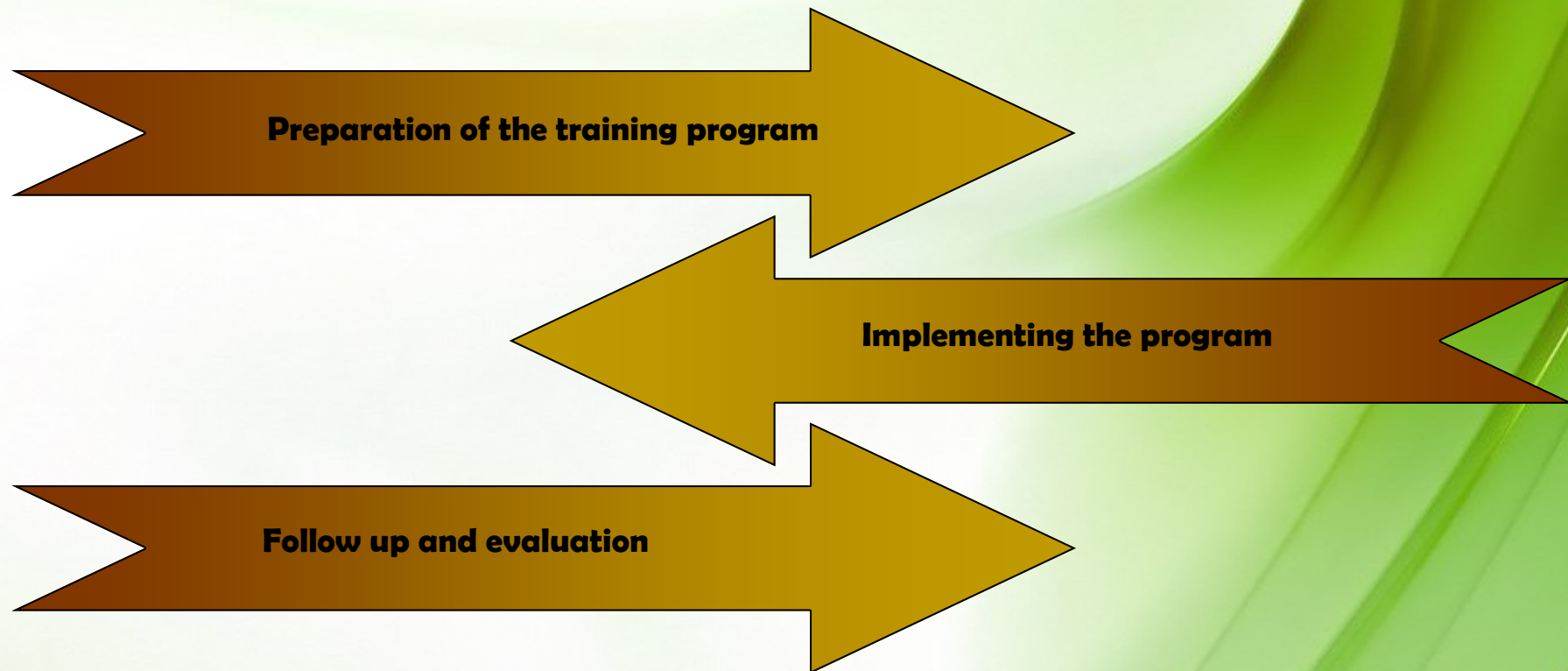


OUR TRAINING PHILOSOPHY

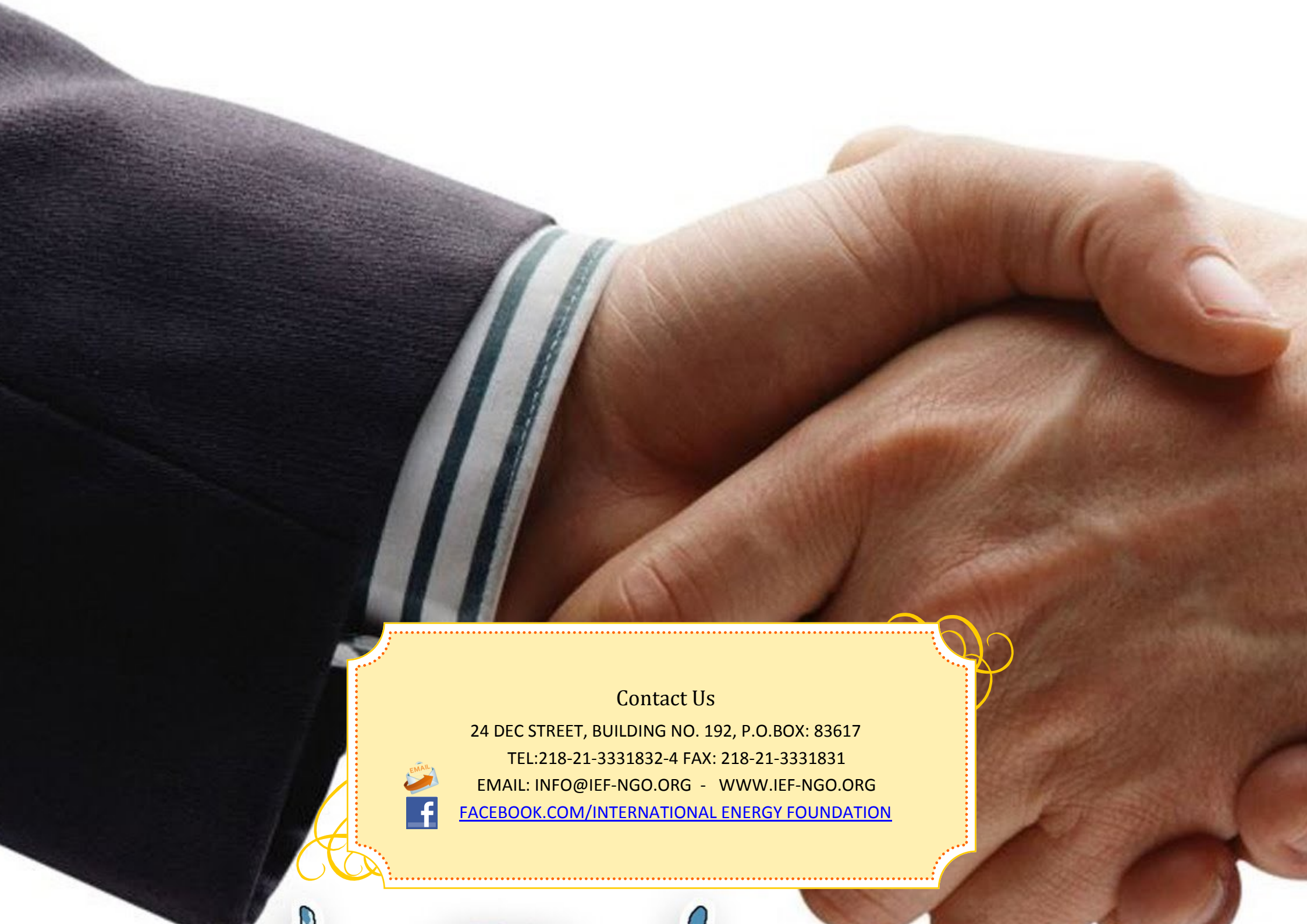
